Last year we made a concerted effort to raise our children's awareness about the environment and ways we can all help to make a difference.

To continue along these lines, we are offering families the opportunity to "go electronic" to reduce the paperwork sent home in your child's folder. Imagine receiving a quick email with attachments instead of multiple sheets of paper that inevitably get tossed out (hopefully into the recycle bin)! And for those of us with more than one child, (i.e., more than one set of papers that may not apply to us), think of the paper we could save by receiving these notices once a week via email. In fact, other elementary schools who have implemented an electronic communication system have reported a savings of **5,000** sheets of paper each week (over **25 trees** saved each year!!!).

Additionally, allowing Hage to communicate with you via email will save costs on toner, paper, and repairs on our over-worked copiers. So, please take a moment to complete this form and return it in your child's folder. And then congratulate yourself on saving your own tree!
