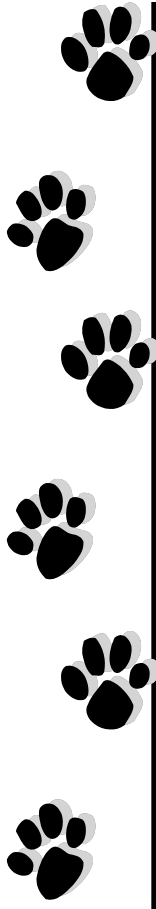

A Message from Mr. T. and Mrs. Sandoval...

It is so hard to believe that this school year is coming to a close. We both feel that this year has gone by so fast. It seems like it was only a few weeks ago that we were getting underway to start our year off as the new administration team for Hage.

In looking back at this school year, we feel so pleased and fortunate to be part of such a wonderful school with great students, staff, parents and community members. For this school year one of our goals was to build good relationships with the students, staff and all of you. Some of the ways we were able to achieve this goal was through our implementation of our Friday Morning Openings, our work with our ASB, our new panther buck system and student store, morning and afternoon traffic supervision and from attending various school meetings and events. One big event for our staff that brought us closer together was our first annual Hage Faculty Follies. This event brought enjoyment for our staff, parents and especially our students. We intend to make this event a new tradition for Hage Elementary. It is fun to discover the hidden talents within our staff.

Another important part of our leadership at Hage was to make ourselves highly visible and easy to approach about school related concerns or issues. We both believe the importance in leading by walking around the campus and checking in with staff and the Hage Community. This belief really helps keep us informed on all the academic and operational happenings going on at Hage. We will continue with this practice, but will also add some other ways to ensure good levels of communication with all of you. One thing we will do more of is having admin chats which will be called "Treats with Mr. T and Mrs. Sandoval." We would like to have these 4 to 6 times during the school year sometimes in the morning and sometimes in the evening. This will just be an informal discussion about what is going on at Hage.

We understand the importance of continuing our efforts to ensure high student performance both academically and socially. At this time we have an API score of 872 which is 15 points higher than 2008-2009. Our hope is to be added to the small group of elementary schools in our district with an API score of 900.

We both anticipate another great year at Hage for 2010-2011. Some new things coming for next year is a new district math curriculum and at Hage we will also be implementing systematic English Language Development or ELD in classrooms to lift the English proficiency for students that are second language learners.

We again want to thank you for your support in making this a wonderful first year for us at Hage. Your effort and support plays a big part in making Hage Elementary a great place to be. Thanks and have a fun and safe summer.

## Where Do PTA Funds Go?

Throughout the year here at Hage we have several fundraisers sponsored by the PTA. What things are funded by the profits raised and how much of it is used? Here's a snapshot of where PTA funds go.

- \* \$5,000 - Field trip bus expenses
- \* \$3,000 -School copier support
- \* \$6,000- Classroom supplies
- \* \$13,000- Art Corps Program
- \* \$1,000 -Student awards
- \* \$7,000 -Swimming
- \* \$3,300 – Scholastic News

Thanks to the parents and families of Hage, the HAGE PTA can continue to fund these value-added, educational programs and activities.

After securing the School District's approval to begin a "trial program" to put window air conditioners into 4th and 5th grade classrooms, the HAGE DADS' CLUB need your help.

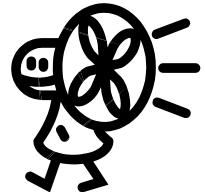
This "trial period" is to prove the hypothesis: that new air conditioners will cost less and consume less energy than the existing ceiling fans.
